Maintenance Corner

As we are well into the summer months, with Temperatures and Humidity levels at high levels, we must ensure that all windows stay closed and locked. This will keep humidity from entering the home and mixing with cold air from the HVAC system. When this occurs it causes excess moisture in the air that can cause an environmental issue inside the home in HVAC vents, duct work, ETC. Also in the summer months be aware of items stored in outside storage closets, and garages, as these areas are not air-conditioned spaces. Clothing, Furniture, Fabric materials, and cardboard can collect moisture, and with added heat, can cause environmental concern. Items in these areas should be kept in plastic storage containers with lids to prevent moisture from wicking into such materials.


